

## JACK'S PLACE – GEAR LIST

### Necessary Items:

- Bedding (sleeping bag and pillow) (limited beds but plenty of floor space and the verandah)
- Towels and personal hygiene items
- Clothing
- Lighting (torch minimum)
- Food and drinks
- Matches/lighter
- Garbage bag
- Toilet paper
- \$25/trip to help cover maintenance and insurance. Money collected in the past has been used for purchase and installation of rain water tanks, wood stove, hot water system, painting, solar panels, batteries, lighting etc.

### Other Items Which You Should Bring, ie Do Not Assume These Are Available

- Soap
- Detergent
- Pot Scourer
- Tea towel
- Paper towels
- Alfoil (if needed for your cooking)
- Comfortable camping chair
- Sleeping mat (10 mattresses available)

### Items Supplied At Jack's Place

- Wood stove and wood
- Cutlery/cooking utensils
- Cooking pots/kettles/frying pans
- Plates/bowls/mugs
- Clean potable water
- Hot showers (when wood stove has been fired up)
- Gas fridge (smallish, limited room)
- Four burner gas stove

### Donations Of The Following Items, Often In Short Supply, Are Gratefully Received

- Soap
- Liquid hand soap
- Detergent
- Paper Towels
- Garbage bags
- Matches
- Toilet paper
- Split pine (non-treated) to start stove

### Housekeeping at Jack's Place

- Cans/plastics/bottles go into a recycle bin. Someone has to volunteer to take this home for recycling. This should be shared around by regular users of Jack's Place.
- Compostable items go into a composting bin for burial.
- Other rubbish goes into the scraps bin. Again it has to be taken out, preferably by the regulars.
- Scrape food scraps and fats etc into bin, *not the sink which clogs up easily.*
- Assist with sweeping up at end of weekend.
- Volunteer to cut some firewood.
